



# MARCH BOARD REPORT



## HIGHLIGHTS

The former General Electric Plant in Niles is currently going through an environmental cleanup with the plan to turn the brownfield into an Industrial Park to create jobs for the area. The Land Bank has been working closely with the City of Niles and a private developer to complete the project.

Building off the success of the gas station survey, the Land Bank has also created a survey asking for help from the public to identify vacant and abandoned brownfield locations. This could include former, dry cleaners, service stations, laundromats, and manufacturing sites.

## CONTRACTOR OUTREACH WORKSHOP

The Land Bank partnered with Trumbull Neighborhood Partnership, Ohio Department of Development and 717 Credit Union to host a contractor outreach workshop to walk new and potential contractors through the Land Bank's programs. The Land Bank is currently seeking contractors for lead remediation work as well as home repair.
